Internet Crimes Against Children FTEs:

ICAC Section is requesting one state funded attorney position, one state funded forensic investigator position and one federally grant funded investigator position. As the ICAC Task Force has grown, arrests have increased virtually every year for at least the past ten years. Additionally, the amount of Cybertips from the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children has risen 280% in five years. With more investigations and arrests, there are naturally more cases to prosecute. These cases can be highly technical and traditionally require more time to prepare for prosecutors. Additional investigators would assist the section with its current case backlog, allowing the forensic team to quickly process and finalize cases for trial. With the increase in caseload and preparation necessary for these types of cases, additional staff are needed to ensure cases can be prosecuted promptly.

Crime Victim Assistance – Supplemental Allocation for Victim Services (SAVS):

Victims of crime rely on advocates, domestic violence shelters, rape crisis centers, and other services more than ever. The single greatest source of support for victims of crime programs are Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) subgrants, which cover all 46 counties. These federal funds have been cut 58% nationwide since FY18. As a result, victim services provided by county, municipal and non-profit agencies in South Carolina are being sharply reduced. This includes advocates who work one-on-one with crime victims as they recover.

In July 2021, Congress passed the VOCA Fix Act, which aims to increase the federal Crime Victims Trust Fund and hopefully result in restored allocations to the states in the future. Until that time, the foundational victim services supported by the VOCA program will continue to diminish unless supplemented by state legislative funds.

This request seeks funding to support the VOCA program for one year by supplementing federal grant funds that pass through the SC Office of the Attorney General to organizations providing direct services to victims.

In 2022, our Office was fortunate enough to receive \$10 million in one-time funding from the state legislature. This funding allowed our office to create a new grant funding program, Supplemental Allocation for Victims Services (SAVS). SAVS mirrors the VOCA program almost identically and has enabled our office to avoid any further cuts to subrecipient organizations. Unfortunately, however, without a further influx of funding from the legislature we expect this program to exhaust its funding by 2024, causing substantial cuts to victim's service agencies throughout the state.

Residential and Emergency Housing for Minor Victims of Human Trafficking Grants:

Currently, the state is severely lacking resources and services for those trafficked in the state. Specifically, the state is in a dire situation with care and services to trafficked minors which consisted of 96% (399 out of 416,) of the trafficking cases reported by SLED in 2022. Those cases have risen in 2023 (446 reported as of Nov 2023) and continue to make a climb. As of this letter, the state has only 10 beds at one location in the low country for all trafficking victims in state, both Adult and Children. Of these 10 beds available, 0 are open to male victims of trafficking both adult and minor. This result has left agencies and victim service providers in ill-equipped positions and victims in a highly vulnerable, dangerous, and sometimes deadly situation.

JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

The Attorney General's Office is requesting \$10.4 million in one-time funding to allocate through competitive solicitation to victim service agencies to establish a minimum of four (4) residential and emergency housing locations for minor victims of human trafficking. Each location is estimated to cost \$1m in startup cost for the building and equipment and approximately \$1.6m recurring cost. This funding would provide a minimum of 45 beds to minor female victims and 15 beds to male victims across the state and provide funding for approximately one-year of operational expenses at each location.

Proposed amendments to §43-7-60 would include a clarification to the definition of a provider to include services provided through Managed Care Organizations and penalties to reflect the amounts of fraudulent claims, similar to property crime statutes.

-There is great interest by our taxpayers in combating fraud in the Medicaid program, and this updated statute would allow us to more effectively combat fraud. The current statute requires us to charge one count for each false claim, which is not in the best interest of judicial economy. A statute where we can aggregate the false claims into one charge will be much more efficient. This update also reflects the current Medicaid environment, with services being provided through Managed Care Organizations and not just the South Carolina Department of Health and Human Services.

Proposed amendments to §43-7-90 would allow us to use subpoenas in our investigations.

-Much of the evidence uncovered during our investigations is stored in another state or in the cloud, so the ability to use a subpoena is paramount to our continued fight against fraud. Additionally, it is burdensome and an additional cost to taxpayers for our investigators to have to travel to the county where the fraud occurred in order to have a search warrant issued by a magistrate. This is a much more efficient use of time and resources.

SUMMARY

Proposed amendments to §43-35-10 would prohibit the unauthorized videotaping or recording of vulnerable adults.

-It is in the best interest of the people of South Carolina to protect our vulnerable adult population from harassment and abuse, and this amendment would close a perceived loophole in the Omnibus Adult Protection Act allowing unauthorized recording of these

individuals.
