On October 23, 2023 the Nexus for Advanced Resilient Energy (SC Nexus) received designation as one of 31 Regional Technology and Innovation Hubs (Tech Hubs) from the US Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration (EDA). SC Nexus is a broad consortium of higher education institutions, tech colleges, state agencies, the Savannah River National Laboratory, economic development alliances, community organizations, non-profits and private companies, led by SC Commerce. The bipartisan CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 authorized \$10 billion over five years for the EDA to launch Regional Tech Hubs across the country.

As part of the FY2023 Consolidated Appropriations Act, Congress appropriated EDA \$500 million to launch the program. With a Tech Hub designation, SC Nexus is applying for Phase II funding, with applications due February 29, 2024, to compete for up to \$75 million to fund technology innovations projects in the state. As a Tech Hub, SC Nexus will also have the opportunity to directly apply for future Tech Hubs implementation funding.

This request is to stand up a division within SC Commerce – SC Nexus – to carry out the programmatic and operational responsibilities, that come with a Regional Tech Hub designation. This request will fund 6 FTE, provide for daily operations and costs relating to the implementation for designation as a Tech Hub, and allow additional funding for grants related to the mission of SC Nexus.

In 2015, for the Navy Base Intermodal Facility (NBIF) project to continue moving forward on a timeline that would allow it to be open near the time of completion of the Hugh K. Leatherman Terminal, Commerce issued an intra-agency loan to Palmetto Railways in the amount of \$51 million as interim, interest -free financing for permitting and preliminary construction costs. The intra-agency loan funds originate from committed, but unexpended grant funds of the South Carolina Coordinating Council for Economic Development, and accordingly, were loaned only on a temporary basis and must be repaid. Since the mid-1970's the SC Department of Commerce has maintained operations in Europe to serve, and stimulate, the interest of European firms' desire to locate/relocate to South Carolina. Since then, Commerce's European operations have relocated to Munich, Germany to provide more focus to German firms. Also, due to growing international interest in South Carolina, Commerce is funding operations in Asia (South Korea, Taiwan, and Japan).

In prior years, Commerce has funded these international operations from its Global Business Development operating appropriations. Due to increased interest across Europe along with inflation, funding foreign operations from these traditional sources is unsustainable in the long-term. European inflation in 2021 was 2.59%, and in 2022 was 8.38%. Through July 2023, inflation is averaging 6.65%. Inflation in the US is similarly high.

JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

In December 2023 South Carolina became one of four states to sign Memorandums of Understanding with the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to deepen the ties and address barriers in the areas of trade and investment. With the passage of Brexit, the UK is further separated from the European Union and looking to grow partnerships and locations for business. Since 2018, the UK and Ireland have accounted for \$178.5 Million in investment and 975 jobs in South Carolina. Currently the UK is South Carolina's fifth largest trading partner, and in 2022 accounted for \$3.2 billion in trade activity, with \$1.7 billion in imports and \$1.5 billion in exports. For these reasons, SC Commerce is evaluating options for a physical presence in the United Kingdom, allowing the state to build on growing relationships developed via the MOU and allow for the development of relationships with various industry groups in the automotive and life science industries.

Due to rising costs, domestically and abroad, the current sources of funding will no longer provide the resources required to effectively recruit international firms to the state.

SC Nexus is a broad consortium of higher education institutions, tech colleges, state agencies, the Savannah River National Laboratory, economic development alliances, community organizations, non-profits and private companies, led by SC Commerce. The bipartisan CHIPS and Science Act of 2022 authorized \$10 billion over five years for the EDA to launch Regional Tech Hubs across the country.

JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

As part of the FY2023 Consolidated Appropriations Act, Congress appropriated EDA \$500 million to launch the program. With a Tech Hub designation, SC Nexus is applying for Phase II funding, with applications due February 29, 2024, to compete for up to \$75 million to fund technology innovations projects in the state. As a Tech Hub, SC Nexus will also have the opportunity to directly apply for future Tech Hubs implementation funding.

Phase II grants will be awarded with a 10% matching requirement. This request will ensure that SC Nexus has adequate funds for this requirement, along with additional funds to make additional awards to further the mission of SC Nexus. SC Commerce expects that showing the EDA the state has more than enough matching funds to support the goals of the Tech Hubs will be beneficial to SC Nexus receiving Phase II funding. These funds will also be used to cover the costs associated with implementation for designation as a Tech Hub.

In 2015, for the Navy Base Intermodal Facility (NBIF) project to continue moving forward on a timeline that would allow it to be open near the time of completion of the Hugh K. Leatherman Terminal, Commerce issued an intra-agency loan to Palmetto Railways in the amount of \$51 million as interim, interest free financing for permitting and preliminary construction costs. The intra-agency loan funds originate from committed, but unexpended grant funds of the South Carolina Coordinating Council for Economic Development, and accordingly, were loaned only on a temporary basis and must be repaid. Commerce is requesting \$20 million in non-recurring funding to partially repay this intra-agency loan. The outstanding balance as of FY23-24 is \$46 million. This request, in conjunction with recurring request priority 1, will ensure that the loan is repaid in a timely manner.

South Carolina does not have a recurring funding mechanism to address significant state infrastructure needs that are necessary for the state to continue and capitalize on its economic development success. Currently, the state addresses the need to modernize or construct new infrastructure based on population density or individual economic development projects. This approach leaves significant infrastructure gaps and inhibits the state from responding to business needs in a timely fashion. These types of large, strategic state infrastructure projects generally exceed Commerce's grant funding resources (except when a project qualifies for economic development bond funding). Accordingly, there is no meaningful way for Commerce to fund an infrastructure need without doing so on a project-by-project basis. South Carolina's ability to build strategic economic infrastructure independent of specific projects and supported by an appropriate funding mechanism is paramount to the state's ability to remain competitive. Proviso 50.23 (Strategic Economic Development Fund) established the guidelines for awarding SEDI funding – SC Commerce is to identify and recommend potential projects for review and comment by the Joint Bond Review Committee before any funds may be awarded or expended.
