## JUSTIFICATION OF REQUEST

In South Carolina, state and local election officials share in the responsibility of conducting elections. The SEC, as the chief election agency in the state, is responsible for overseeing the overall voter registration and election process. Each year, South Carolina holds approximately 300 elections. There is at least one statewide election in South Carolina every fiscal year. The amount of resources needed and the number of days on which voting actually takes place in South Carolina has increased significantly with the implementation of early voting. The State Election Commission is requesting\$1,500,000 to cover the cost of election expenses. The State Election Commission provides tremendous financial support to the 46 county boards of voter registration and elections to help cover the cost of election expenses. Election expenses include but are not limited to early voting workers, election day workers, legal notices, and printed supplies. Without this financial support, it would be impossible to carry out accessible, efficient, and accurate elections.

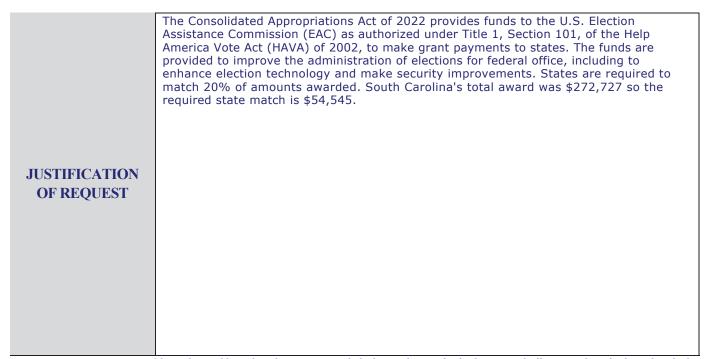
