

## **Coastal Carolina University**

### **CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Expenditure Plan**

Coastal Carolina University was allocated \$10,054,347 under the CARES Act for emergency relief of students and the institution. The University assures that 50 percent of the funds will be used to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. Strategic members of Coastal Carolina University's staff have developed methods to determine which students will receive the emergency funding, as well as how much they will receive.

Method for determining eligibility for Emergency Financial Aid Grants:

- Qualified students who were enrolled as of the last day of classes for Spring 2020 and incurred expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19 will be identified and awarded emergency grants.
- Students who are not eligible for Title IV funding are not eligible for funding from the CARES Act.
- Students who were enrolled only in online classes prior to March 13 will not be eligible for funding.
- Students with the greatest documented need using the Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) will be prioritized. Individual disbursement amounts will vary by student dependent on levels of financial need, as defined by Title IV regulations.
- A portion of the funds will be reserved for eligible students to apply for additional funding based on higher incurred expenses. The application will be reviewed by the University's Benevolence Fund committee and eligible students will be awarded based on need.
- CCU Financial Aid & Scholarships will verify eligibility in accordance with the CARES Act.

Coastal Carolina University will utilize the remaining 50 percent of the CARES Act allocation to cover institutional costs related to the disruption of campus operations, such as procuring technology and hiring support personnel to enhance online learning and enable students to successfully transition to online and hybrid instruction models.
