

What is it?

Agencies can request an increase to their Other Funds budget authorization during the fiscal year.

Why?

During a fiscal year, an agency may determine that they need an increase in Other Funds authorization that cannot be addressed by transferring existing authority.

Which law addresses this situation?

Budget proviso 91.20 (Other Funds Oversight Committee) states that a joint committee with members from the House of Representatives and the Senate will “review each request and recommend appropriate action.” The proviso further provides that Other Funds do not refer to General Funds or Federal Funds.

What is the process?

After consulting with their budget analyst, an agency may complete an Other Funds Authorization form and the required budget entry in SCEIS. The Executive Budget Office will coordinate requests with the Other Funds Oversight Committee who will hold a public meeting. If recommended for approval, the EBO will process the budget entry in SCEIS.

Will the increase to Other Funds authority be included in the base for the following fiscal year?

No. The agency will need to submit a request through the budget process.
